

About the colloquium

As we live in the “information age”, Information Technology (IT) has become a part of our everyday lives. It has a great impact on our society. IT can be a very powerful tool that can be harnessed efficiently and effectively to provide resources and services to those who need them and can be used as a mechanism to solve the growing social problems.

This academic year it will be held on **18th & 19th January 2019** and will be a **state level event**. The objective of the colloquium is to provide exposure to the attendees with applications of IT in various domains of society like entertainment, transportation, healthcare, agriculture etc. However, this year’s colloquium theme is focused on **IT in M2M communication, IT in Travel/Tourism and IT in Logistics**.

At the colloquium, the participants will get an opportunity to showcase their own ideas and learn from interaction with experts and fellow participants. Along with this, every attendee will get a certificate of participation and a chance to win prizes.
