Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) Between

St. Francis Institute of Technology, Mumbai, Maharashtra

And

Cyber Sanskar, Nashik, Maharashtra

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MoU') is entered into on **31st January, 2025** by and between **St. Francis Institute of Technology (Autonomous), Department of Computer Engineering**, situated at Mt. Painsur, S.V.P Road, Borivli West, Mumbai 400103, an autonomous engineering college affiliated to the University of Mumbai and approved by the All India Council of Technical Education (AITCE) and Directorate of Technical Education (DTE), Government of Maharashtra, hereinafter referred to as **"The First Party"** for the sake of brevity

AND

Cyber Sanskar, a company situated at Nashik, Maharashtra, hereinafter referred to as the **"Second Party"** for the sake of brevity.

The First Party is represented by the Director of the institute **Bro. Shantilal Kujur** and the Head of the Department of Computer Engineering, **Dr. Kavita Sonawane**, and the Second Party is represented by **Dr. Tanmay S. Dikshit**, Founder and CEO, Cyber Sanskar.

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WHERE AS

The First Party, is a Higher Technical Educational Institution and the **Second Party**, is involved in Product development and Training Industry.

AND WHERE AS

Both First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effectiveness in the areas of Cyber Security, Technical Education, Training and Research, to improve skill-based education and professional placement opportunities.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this MoU, the parties hereto agree as follows:

CLAUSE 1: SCOPE OF THE MoU - COOPERATION

- 1) Both the Parties commit and agree to cooperate by utilizing their respective resources to foster skill-based education, internships, and research projects in the areas of Cyber Security, Industry 4.0, and related technologies.
- 2) The parties shall also cooperate to facilitate Faculty Development Programs (FDP), Short-Term Training Programs (STTP) and other workshops to promote the understanding of emerging cyber technologies.

CLAUSE 2: TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT

- 1) The Second Party, commits and agrees to deliver training programs, including workshops, conferences, and hands-on practical sessions in areas such as Cyber Forensics, Digital Marketing, and Industry 4.0 awareness.
- 2) The Second Party also commits and agrees to provide digital certification, E-Infrastructure support and study materials for all training programs.
- 3) Both parties commit and bind themselves through this MoU to collaborate in establishing a **Centre of Excellence** in Cyber Security in the Department of Computer Engineering of the First Party. This Centre will focus on research, industry collaboration, and cutting-edge education to equip students and faculty with the latest skills.

CLAUSE 3: INTERNSHIP AND PLACEMENT

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The Second Party agrees and commits to offer internships and placement opportunities for deserving students in collaboration with relevant industry partners.

CLAUSE 4: CYBER SECURITY AND GENERATIVE AI LAB

The Second Party commits and agrees to aid in the **setup of an industry-aided Cyber Security and Generative AI Lab**, which will include web-based software for password testing, data security, and website security scanning in the Department of Computer Engineering.

CLAUSE 5: SPONSORSHIP AND COLLABORATION

- 1) The Second Party commits to provide academic sponsorship letters to all students who successfully submit working projects, aiding them in further academic or professional pursuits.
- 2) Both parties agree to collaborate on National and International research projects, student contests, and hackathons, including Cyber Olympiads.

CLAUSE 6: DELIVERABLES

1) Deliverables of Second Party to the Students, Staff and Research Scholars of the First Party:

- a) Support for **E-Infrastructure establishment** by defining requirements and validating software and hardware setups.
- b) Deliver successfully Short-Term Training Programs (STTP), Faculty Development Programs (FDP), and Quality Improvement Programs (QIP).
- c) Provide a **Digital Kit**, including study material, software, and tools, to ensure comprehensive learning.
- d) Provide an adequate training team comprising experts and assistants and ensuring the completion of all courses.

2) Deliverables of St. Francis Institute of Technology (First Party):

- a) Host, publicize and market the workshops both internally and externally.
- b) Provide hospitality (lodging, boarding, and pick-up/drop-off services) for Cyber Sanskar's team during the workshops at no additional cost.

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- c) Provide accommodation and hospitality to visiting participants during workshops, with the option to charge nominal fees for participants if necessary.
- d) Provide a hall or room with ICT facilities for hosting the workshop with a seating capacity ranging from 150 to 350.
- e) Permit to use its name and logo on corporate merchandise, including posters, proposals, certificates, websites, forums, press releases, and media coverage.
- f) Designate Second Party as an official sponsor (workshop partner) on its event website and include the Second Party's name and logo on all promotional materials, such as posters, Android apps, newsletters, and other media.
- g) Provide a list of coordinators, ambassadors, and students with the Second Party to ensure smooth coordination for all events.

CLAUSE 7: FINANCIALS

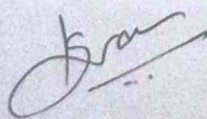
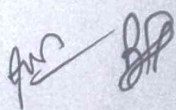
Both parties agree that there will be no financial commitment unless mutually decided upon and formalized under separate agreements.

This MoU is valid for a period of **5 years** from the date of signing the MoU. However, it can be extended or terminated by mutual written consent of either party with a 30-day notice period.

CLAUSE 9: MISCELLANEOUS

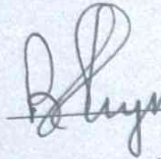
- 1) The relationship under this MoU shall be non-exclusive, and both parties agree to work together in good faith for mutual benefit.
- 2) Any amendments or extensions to this MoU shall be in writing and agreed upon by both parties.



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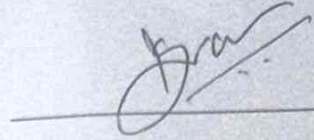
