NATIONAL READING DAY – JUNE 19 REPORT

The National Education Policy 2020 has placed emphasis on 'how to read', 'learn to read', read to learn' and underscored the critical role played by Public/School/Digital libraries towards this end. The P. N. Panicker Foundation has been a key contributor in this area.

Honouring the father of the Library Movement, the late P.N. Panicker, 19th June is being celebrated as Reading Day and the following week as the Reading Week. Started as a Reading Day Celebration on 19th June 1996, it has become a mass movement to promote the culture of reading. On 19th June 2017, Hon'ble Prime Minister launched the 22nd National Reading Month Celebrations and gave a clarion call to propagate the message of 'Read and Grow' among all the citizens of the country by 2022. The 26th National Reading Day will be celebrated on 19th June 2021, the following week as Reading Week and Reading Month will be celebrated from 19th June to 18th July 2021. In the light of COVID19 pandemic, the P.N. Panicker Foundation has initiated and designed different online reading related activities. 
Started as a Reading Day Celebration on 19th June, 1996, by the Govt. of Kerala along with P.N. Panicker Foundation it has become a mass movement to promote to culture of reading so as to inculcate the habit of reading and promote book mindedness among school children, youth as well as the underprivileged population of the country. Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, came down to Kerala and launched the 22nd National Reading/ Digital Reading Month Celebrations on 19th June, 2017 at Kochi. The Prime Minister gave a clarion call to propagate the message of Vayichu Valaruka (Read and Grow) to 300 million Indian citizens by 2022 when the country celebrate its 75th year of independence. The Prime Minister directed P.N. Panicker Foundation to promote digital reading also so as to use digital technology in all educational tools of the country.

The Government of Kerala and the Government of India through NITI Aayog has entrusted the responsibility of observing National Reading/ Digital Reading Month Celebrations to P N Panicker Foundation and P N Panicker Vigyan Vikas Kendra.

SFIT LIRC and NDLI Club organized an Online Quiz on the topic "IEEE Xplore Digital Library" to motivate students to use the IEEE Xplore Resources more effectively. 61 students responded to the Quiz.

27 February is the birthday of Dnyanpeeth Award-winning author, playwright V. Shirewadkar alias Kavi Kusumagraj This day is celebrated worldwide as 'World Marathi Language Day'. Worshiping Kusumagraj, whose stylus has made a distinct impression in the literature of the country and the world!

क्सुमाग्रज

वि.वा. शिरवाडकर यांचे खरे नांव गजानन रंगनाथ शिरवाडकर दत्तक गेल्यामुळे त्यांचे नांव विष्णु वामन शिरवाडकर झाले. २७ फेब्रुवारी १९१२ साली त्यांचा जन्म झाला. प्राथमिक शिक्षण पिपंळगाव येथे झाले. तर माध्यमिक शिक्षण नाशिक येथील न्यू इंग्लीश स्कुलमध्ये म्हणजे आजचे जे जु. स. रुंगठा विद्यालय आहे तेथे झाले. मॅट्रिक परिक्षा ते मुंबई विद्यापीठातून पास झाले.

१९३० साली हं. प्रा. ठाकरसी विद्यालयात ते होते तेव्हा 'रत्नाकर' मासिकातुन त्यांच्या किवता प्रसिध्द होत. अस्पृश्य समजल्या जाणाऱ्या लोकांना काळाराम मंदिरात प्रवेश मिळावा म्हणून १९३२ साली जो सत्याग्रह झाला त्यात त्यांनी सहभाग घेतला होता, त्यामूळे बाल्यावस्थेतील त्यांच्या लिखाणाला प्रौढत्वाची लकाकी चढून हळूहळू त्यांच्या साहित्याने आकाशाला गवसणीच घातली. ज्यात त्यांनी फक्त किवताच नाही तर कथा, कादंबऱ्या, नाटके, लित साहित्य याबरोबर प्रभा साप्ताहिक, प्रभात वृत्तपत्र, सारथी, धनुर्धारी व नवयुग यामध्ये पत्रकारिता पण केली. त्यांचा आवडता लेखक पी. जी. वुडहाऊस व आवडता नट चार्ली चाप्लिन होता.

१९४२ साली प्रसिध्द झालेला 'विशाखा' हा काव्यसंग्रह म्हणजे मराठी वाङमयातील उच्च कोटीचे वैभव होय. जे आजही मराठी साहित्यप्रेमींना भुरळ घालते. 'मराठी माती', 'स्वागत', 'हिमरेषा' यांचबरोबर 'ययाती आणि देवयानी' व 'वीज म्हणाली धरतीला' ही नाटके १९६० ते १९६६ साली प्रसिध्द झाली. साऱ्या साहित्य कृतींना राज्य पुरस्कारांनी सन्मानित करण्यात आले आहे. १९४६ साली 'वैष्णव' ही कादंबरी व 'दूरचे दिवे' हे नाटक प्रसिध्द झाले.

'नटसम्राट' ही त्यांच्या लेखणीतून उतरलेली सर्वोत्कृष्ट कलाकृती तर होतीच पण त्याचे नाटयप्रयोगही खूप गाजले. नाटयवेडया मराठी रिसकांनी त्यांचे अभूतपूर्व स्वागत केले. अत्यंत नाजुक व भावुक विषयाला हाताळणारे हे नाटक वयोवृध्दांचा दृष्टीकोन बदलणारे ठरले कारण अनेक वृध्दांनी हे नाटक पाहिल्यावर आपले मृत्यूपत्र बदलले. तरूणांचाही वृध्दांकडे पहाण्याचा दृष्टीकोन बदलला.

कुसुमाग्रज एक वेगळं व्यक्तिमत्व

त्यांच्या साहित्य प्रवासाबरोबर माणूस म्हणून त्याचं वेगळं व्यक्तिमत्व अभ्यासायचं तर अनेक पैलूनी ते पहावे लागेल. नाशिकमधील अनेक चळवळींचे ते प्रणेते होते. उदाहरणार्थ, त्यांनी लोकहितवादी मंडळ १९५० मध्ये सुरू केले. नाशिकच्या प्रसिध्द सार्वजिनक वाचनालयाचे ते १९६२ ते १९७२ पर्यंत अध्यक्ष होते. ते दशक वाचनालयाचे सुवर्णयुग म्हटले पाहीजे. सामाजिक वा वैयक्तिक अशा कुठल्याही प्रकल्पांना ते मार्गदर्शन करीत. कोणीही कुठल्याही प्रकारचे मार्गदर्शन मार्गण्यास आला तर क्षणात त्या व्यक्तीची क्षमता ओळखून ते मदत करीत. असं असूनही यश साजरं करतांना ते मागे राहणंच पसंत करत.

साहित्यसूर्य मावळला

महाराष्ट्राच्या सांस्कृतिक जीवनात कुसुमाग्रजांच्या निधनाने जी पोकळी निर्माण झाली ती कधीच भरून निघणार नाही. नाशिककरांना तर आपल्या घरातील वडीलधारं माणूस गमावल्याचं दु:ख आहे. मानवतेचा कळवळा व मराठी भाषेवरचं प्रभुत्व यामुळेच 'नटसम्राट' व 'विशाखा' सारखे साहित्य जन्माला आले. एवढं उत्तुंग कर्तृत्व व अनेक पुरस्कारांनी सन्मानित व्यक्तिमत्व अत्यंत साधे तर होतेच पण शेवटपर्यंत अत्यंत नम्र व सत्कार्याला वाहून घेतलेले जीवन ते शेवटपर्यंत जगले. शिक्षणक्षेत्रात त्यांनी खूप मार्गदर्शन केले. आजची परीक्षा पध्दती मुलांसाठी निष्ठुर पध्दती आहे असे त्यांचे मत होते. इतरही अनेक क्षेत्रात त्यांनी लोकांना योग्य मार्ग दाखवले. त्यांचे घर म्हणजे तीर्थक्षेत्र झाले होते. त्यांच्या स्मृतिप्रित्यर्थ स्थापण्यात आलेल्या कुसुमाग्रज प्रतिष्ठानाचे समाजातील गरीब, गरजू व मागासलेल्या जनतेसाठी योगदान वाखाणण्यासारखे आहे.

Marathi Bhasha Diwas Celebration 2021: Report



Marathi Bhasha Diwas is celebrated in honour of Marathi language.

SFIT NSS in collaboration with the Learning and Information Resource Centre celebrated 'Marathi Bhasha Din' on the occasion of the birth anniversary of noted Marathi litterateur V. V. Shirwadkar, popularly known as 'Kusumagraj' whose birthday falls on 27th February every year.

Ayush Mohite - student of T.E. ExTC welcomed all the dignitaries, faculty members and students. Our Government has started celebrating the birth anniversary of Kusumagraj as 'Marathi Rajbhasha Gaurav Din' after the Jnanpeeth awardee's demise in 1999.

From the year 2015 <u>Government of Maharashtra - Marathi Language Section</u> had instituted two special awards for individuals taking initiatives to promote Marathi literature.

The Vinda Karandikar Lifetime Achievement Award is conferred to Shri. Ranganath Pathare - a noted Marathi writer. This award consists of a cash prize of Rs. 5 lakhs, a memento and a Citation. Pathare has penned several novels, including *Tamrapat* which won the prestigious Sahitya Academy award in 1999. His 700-page long *Satpatil Kulvruttant* novel was published last year and has been receiving accolades from readers as well as critics.

The Shri. P. Bhagwat Award will be given to Shabdalay Prakashan at Shrirampur in Ahmednagar. This award consists of a cash prize of Rs. 3 lakhs and a Citation.

As part of the celebration, many students recited their self written poems. The judges - Dr. Kavita Sonawane (HOD - Computer Engineering) and Asst. Prof. Sunil Pansare (In-Charge HOD - Mechanical Engineering) and the staff members were enthralled to know the Marathi language skills of today's generation. Sahil Sawant - a student of T.E. ExTC co-ordinated the session of poetry recitation. Manasvi Bhand - a student of T.E. ELEC promptly recited the poems of the persons who were not able to join the session online. This Virtual Celebration brought together young and creative minds whose mother tongue was not Marathi. The following are such students whose mother tongue is not Marathi but they recited their poems with equal command and excellence in Marathi language:

Bhavika Shetty - S.E. ExTC


The judges expressed their views about Kusumagraj and shared their experiences with all the students and faculty members. They also encouraged students to improve their Marathi communication and learning skills.

The Library of St. Francis Institute of Technology celebrated 15th October 2015 as the Reading Inspiration Day for the first time.

The former President of India, Dr. A P J Abdul Kalam 's birth anniversary is observed as 'Vaachan Prerna Din' (Reading Inspiration Day) across Maharashtra, every year. The key objective of the initiative is to ensure that students get inspired by the late Dr. Kalam's distinguished life.

About Dr. Kalam:

Born on 15th October 1931 at Rameswaram in Tamil Nadu, Dr. Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam, specialized in Aeronautical Engineering from Madras Institute of Technology. Dr. Kalam made significant contribution as Project Director to develop India's first indigenous Satellite Launch Vehicle (SLV-III) which successfully injected the Rohini satellite in the near earth orbit in July 1980 and made India an exclusive member of Space Club.

In his literary pursuit four of Dr. Kalam's books - "Wings of Fire", "India 2020 - A Vision for the New Millennium", "My journey" and "Ignited Minds - Unleashing the power within India" have become household names in India and among the Indian nationals abroad. These books have been translated in many Indian languages.

Dr. Kalam is one of the most distinguished scientists of India with the unique honour of receiving honorary doctorates from 30 universities and institutions. He has been awarded the coveted civilian awards - Padma Bhushan (1981) and Padma Vibhushan (1990) and the highest civilian award Bharat Ratna (1997). He is a recipient of several other awards and

Fellow of many professional institutions.

Dr. Kalam became the 11th President of India on 25th July 2002. His focus is on transforming India into a developed nation by 2020.

Reading helps everyone to grow mentally, emotionally & psychologically & open the doors of new knowledge to enlighten the mind.

As part of the celebrations, the Learning and Information Resource Centre (Central Library) initiated a few activities as outlined below:

- 1) Take Away of Books
- 2) Sale of withdrawn books

- 4) Modification of the overdues
- 5) Extending Scholar's Card facility to students whose GPA is =/>8.6.

The LIRC witnessed a huge response for the Take Away of books and the Sale of Withdrawn book bank books. More than 150 people visited the library and an odd 100 availed the same. Staff and students alike were happy and all smiles since almost everybody got something to carry with them.

Book Exhibition was well organized with a majority of the books on "Wireless Communications". Many faculty members glanced through the displayed books and a few selected them too.

The modification in the overdues structure came as a pleasant surprise for the student community and they were more than happy to take note of their reduced fines. From the next semester onward, Scholar's Cards would be extended to students whose GPA is =/> 8.6 thereby maximizing the library's usage.

All in all, the library did mark the Vaachan Prerana Diwas by offering a tribute to the vision and knowledge of Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam.



Take Away of Donated Books: 11th October, 2018




Our faculty members, students -





As part of the virtual celebrations, the library conducted the following two events in collaboration with the NDLI Club:


- 1. Online Quiz on the Life and Times of Dr. A.P. J. Abdul Kalam


Online Book Review Contest

Book Exhibition: 160 books were kept in the exhibition.


