Guide lines for Graduates

A. General:

- Check final list of registered candidates for the convocation ceremony available on college website from 22nd January 2015.
- If for any reason the Graduates or their guests cannot attend the function after registration, the same information must be conveyed to Ms. Elizabeth on phone no: 28928585 or by e-mail <u>sfedu@sfitengg.org</u> at the earliest. This will help us in optimizing the resources and also minimizing the wastage of food.
- The registered guests accompanying the graduate are requested to sit in their reserved seats.
- B. <u>Formal Dress</u>: Graduates are requested to wear formal dress for the function, as indicated below
 - Gents: Lounge Suit/ Combination with tie, black shoes and socks
 - Ladies: Saree / Suit/ Western (Jacket/ Trousers with tie)

C. <u>Time:</u>

- Graduates are expected to reach the venue three hours prior to the ceremony (by 2pm).
- Parents can be at the venue by 5.00 p.m.

D. <u>Registration and refreshments:</u>

Graduates are requested to register themselves at respective department desks (CMPN- room no. 003, EXTC- room no 004, INFT- room no 012). and collect the refreshment packets . (**The Registration closes by 3:30pm**)

Graduates will collect their gowns and caps at respective department desks at
3.35pm. They will be given a registration number which will decide the order of marching as well as seating arrangements.

E. Group Photo of Graduates:

- After collecting their graduation caps and gowns, the graduates are required to proceed for their group photo at 4.00pm.
- Arrangements will be made department wise for group photo of the graduates in the badminton court.

F. Order for the ceremony:

• Graduates are requested to establish order for the ceremony and should take their seats according to their registration numbers. The faculty volunteers will guide them in this regard.

G. <u>During the ceremony:</u>

• Graduates are required to follow the tradition and wear the ceremonial black gown at all times.

- Those who either fail/ refuse to wear the black gown or discard it at any time during the ceremony, SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED to participate in convocation ceremony or to go to the stage.
- They are expected to refrain from pinning anything to the gown and carrying anything (such as, pictures, flowers, food or drink) to the venue which disturbs the programme.
- \circ Mobiles should be either switched off or kept in silent mode.
- All are expected to remain present throughout the ceremony which is expected to last approximately for three hours.

H. Dinner:

- Graduates and the two accompanying guests are invited to attend the reception (dinner) after the ceremony.
- After the ceremony, they must return their gowns and collect the dinner coupons at the respective department registration desk.
- Parents who have been registered for representing their respective ward also need to collect the dinner coupon and the certificate from Physics Lab (room No. 011) after the ceremony.
