
Book Exhibitions and Virtual Displays



World Book and Copyright Day was celebrated from 23rd to 26th April 2023 in the library. A Book Exhibition Cum Take Away was organized for the benefit of all.






142 books donated by gracious persons were displayed. Students and Staff gave a huge response by participating in this exhibition in large numbers.






Collaboration with Other Departments




National Reading Day






IRINS Faculty Profiles
