


January 2021 at 10 am.


Literature, stalwarts of Maharashtra, pioneers of the Marathi language, recipes and poems.

Do watch out for upcoming Book Shelves on Teacher's Day and Reading Inspiration Day.



Faculty members who had joined SFIT for the new semester were given a brief introduction to the library and its resources.






#### WEBINAR ON WOMENS HEALTH AND NUTRITION


# National Digital Library of India Club


