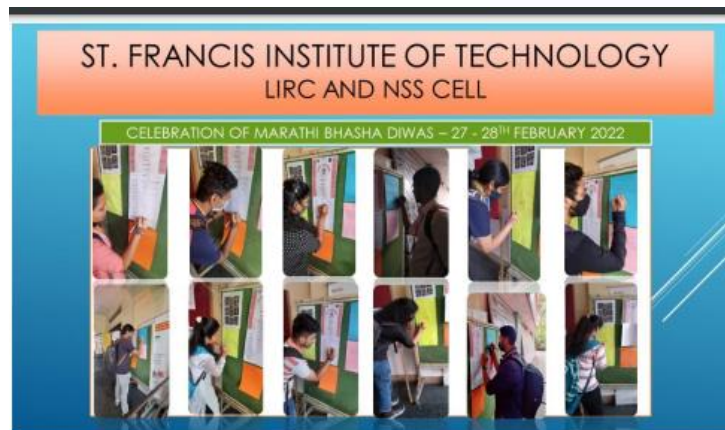
Shri. Bharat Sasane

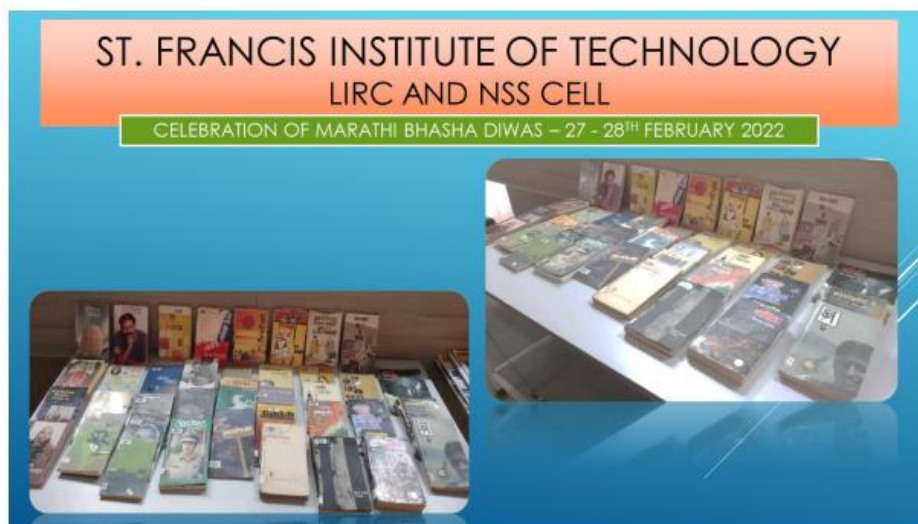

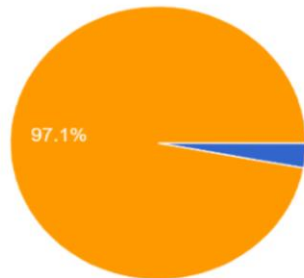

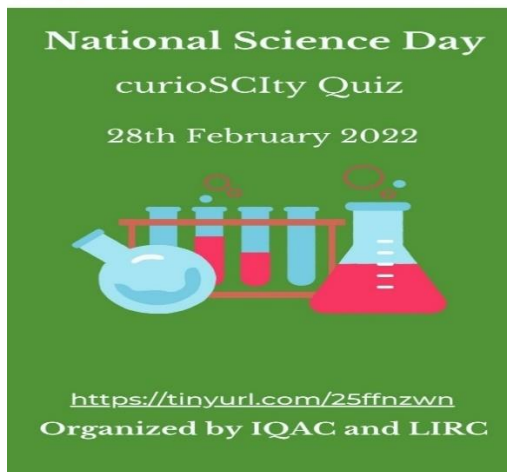

ANNUAL STOCK VERIFICATION 2022

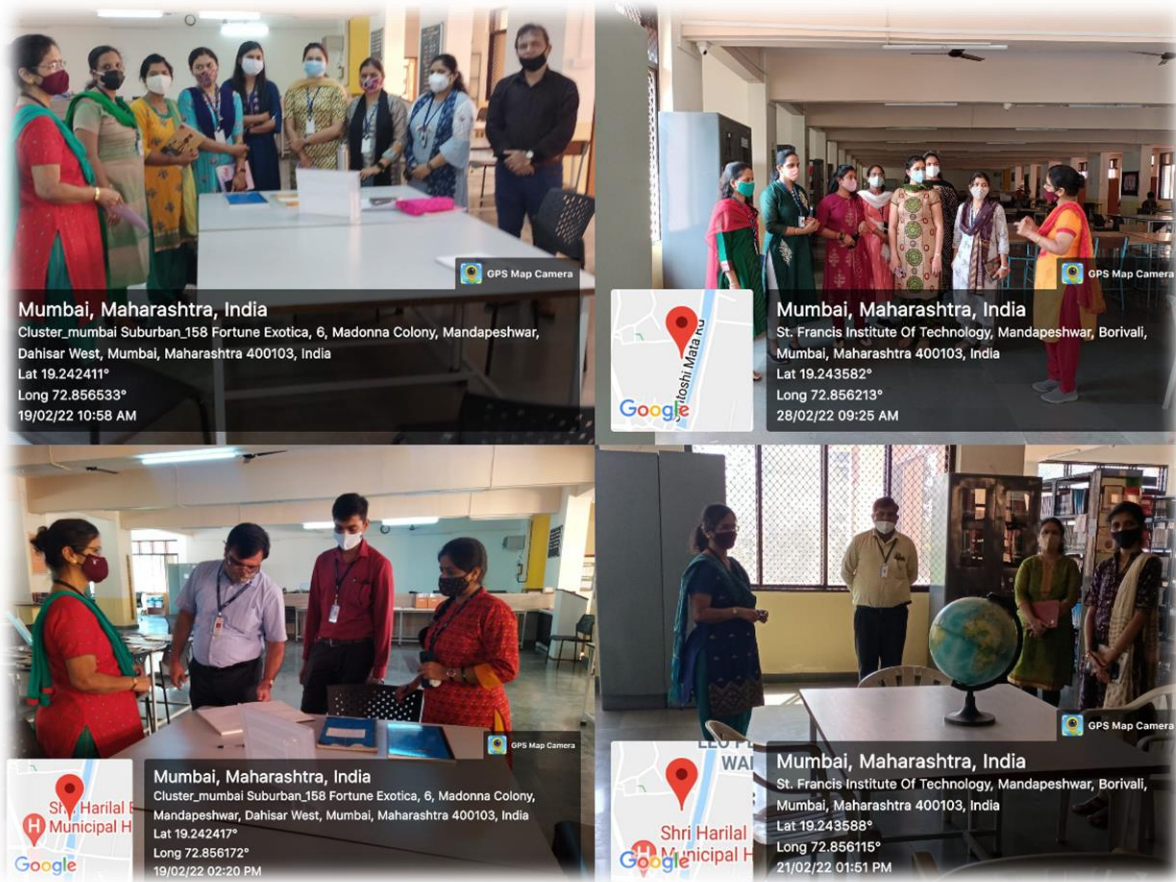

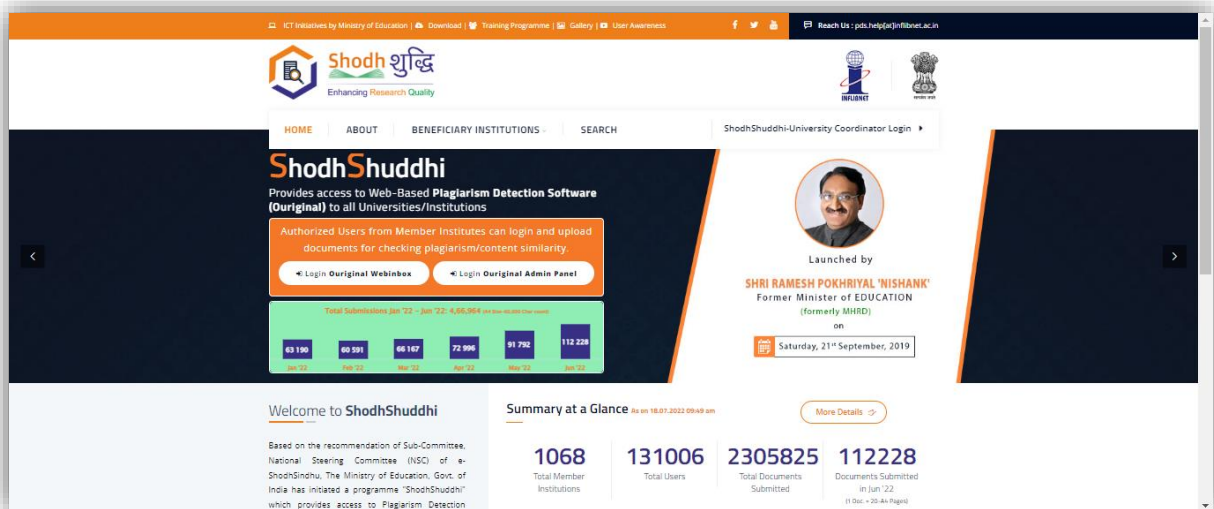

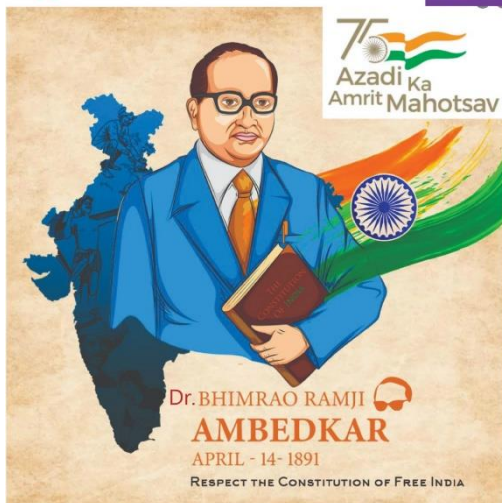
The Drop Everything And Read (DEAR) strategy involves getting learners to stop what they are doing and read for 10 to 20 minutes. It is a method that helps build learners' literacy skills (especially when learners can select their book or journal). However, it is also useful for assisting learners in getting more depth of knowledge (DOK) on a subject being taught when you

give them all an article or book to read to help them gain more insight for subsequent parts of the lesson.

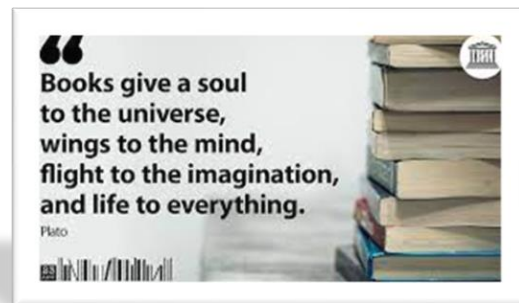
WORLD BOOK AND COPYRIGHT DAY QUIZ ON 23rd April 2022

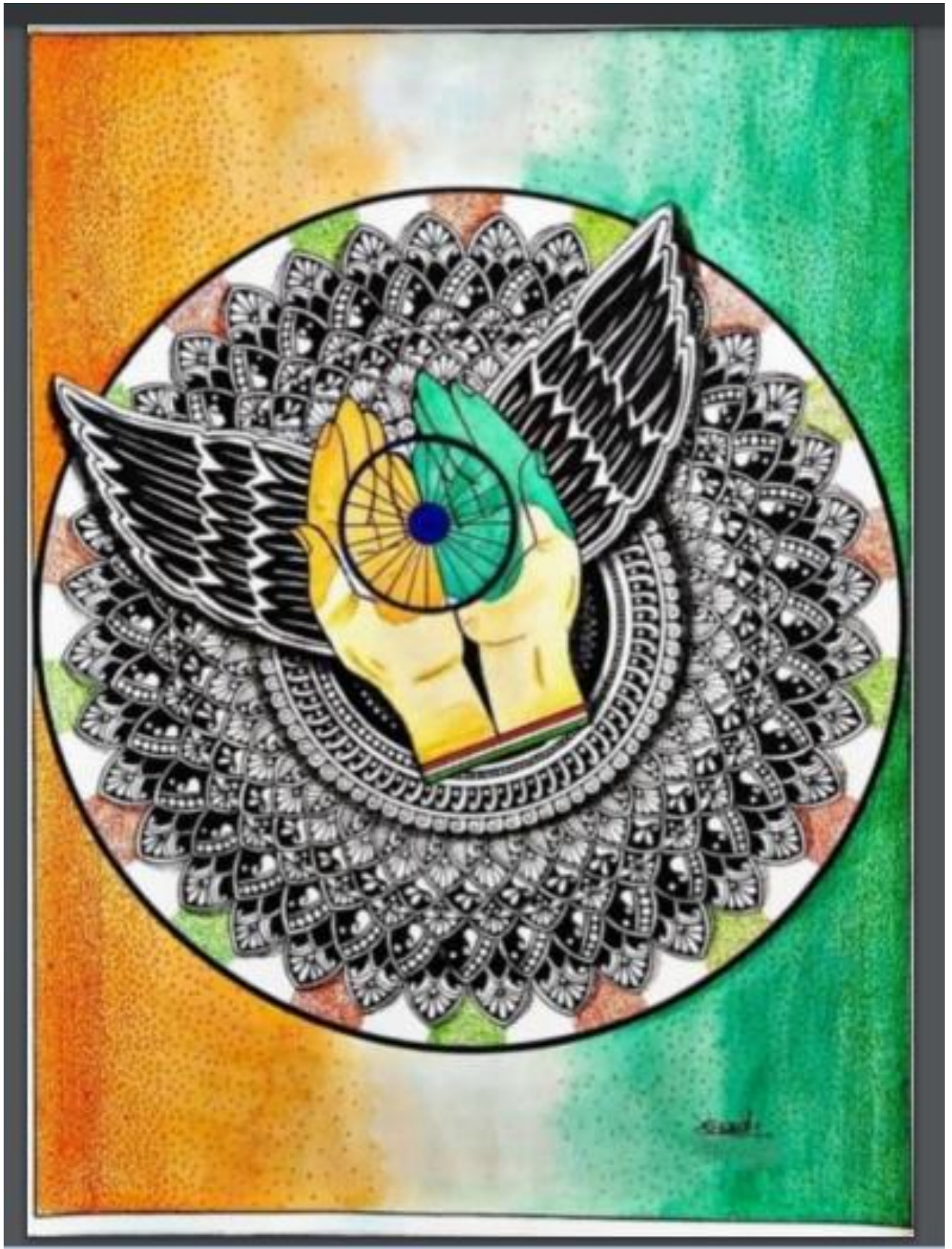
