However, it is also useful for assisting learners in getting more depth of knowledge (DOK) on a subject being taught when you give them all an article or book to read to help them gain more insight for subsequent parts of the lesson.


WORLD BOOK AND COPYRIGHT DAY QUIZ ON 23rd April 2022




