So, a thank you to each and every one of you for being with us all through this unprecedented change.

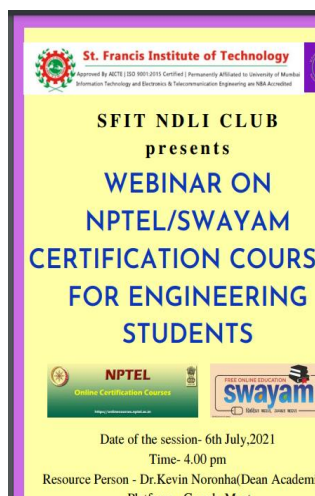

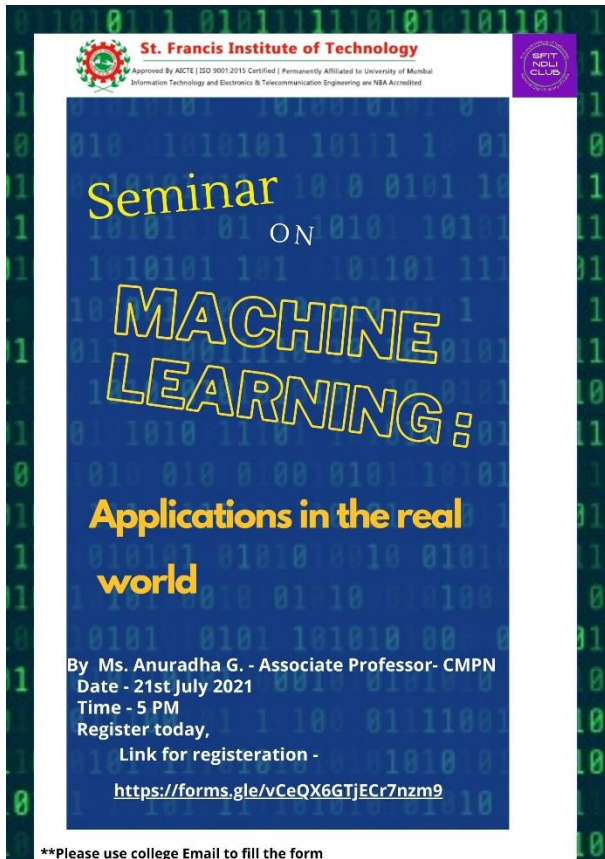

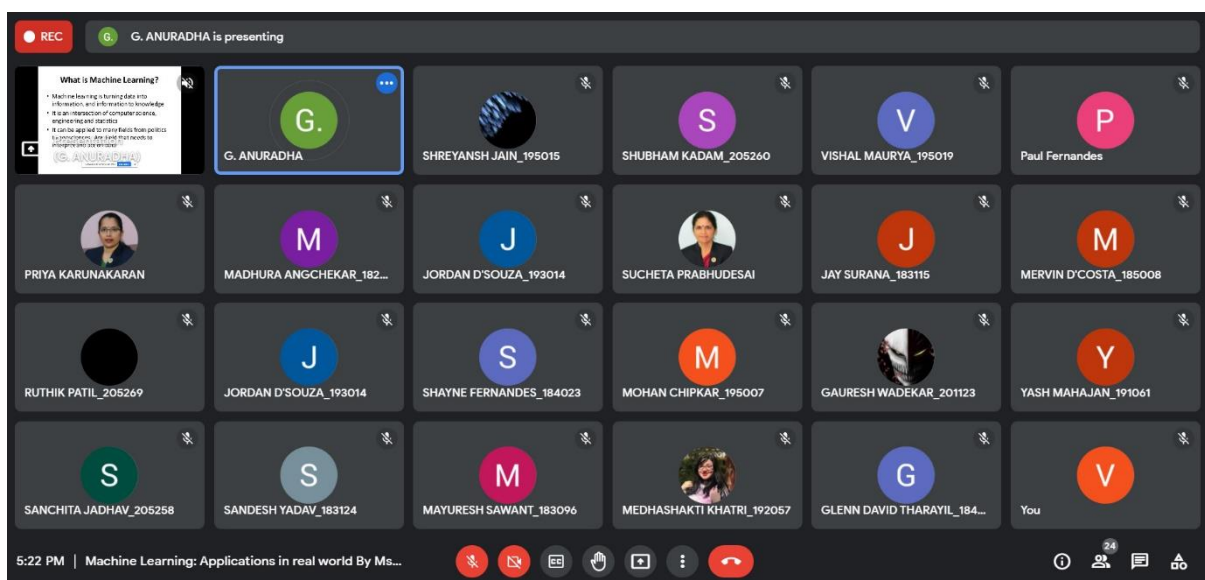
The webinar was attended by students from S.E., T.E. and B.E. of all branches.
