


Commemorating the 75th year of Celebration of Independence "Bharat ki Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav, SFIT-St. Francis Institute of Technology, Mumbai in association with IQAC organised an "E workshop on Mendeley" on 17 September, 2022 at 5.00 pm (IST).

Ms. Amrita Mathur Asst. Prof., INFT Department served as the resource person. Ms. Chinmayee Bhange, (Librarian) and Workshop In-Charge welcomed Ms. Mathur and the participants to the online Workshop. In her opening remark, she stressed the importance of the workshop to the participants in efficiently preparing their Final Year Project Documentation and also the Manuscripts for possible publication in Journals of Impact.

Ms. Amrita Mathur began her presentations with the installation of the Mendeley Desktop. She introduced Mendeley, its genesis and its usefulness for the scientific writing especially in managing the references. She gave a demo on installation of the Mendeley and engaged all the participants through her step by step guidance on using Mendeley and its various features. In her hour long talk combined with demo, she highlighted the features like Mendeley Web Importer, creating library, Synchronising and organising them. She also demonstrated how to manually add references, annotate and highlight, Search/filter to easily locate documents and add literature as an automatic option. She concluded her talk with useful tips on Do's and Don'ts that was followed by brief question and answer session that added clarity to the one hour hands on training session. A total of 25 people attended the session from all over India.


available as free software-as-service to the academic and R&D organisations in India.





Luckily I got the chance to spin the wheel and got "Short Story section". Then I selected a small cute book with lots of expectations, hence so the name of the book "Great Expectation". This book has lots of pictorial representation with story narration. The first few pages itself was quite interesting will grab the

attention to the reader. In just a week period book can be complete even if give half an hour reading time.

The summary of the book is as follows:

There was a time in the British Commonwealth when crimes that would formerly have been punished by death were commuted to a sentence of "transportation." This is to say, the convicted criminals were packed into prison-ships and banished to Australia, to become forced colonists. There they led such a hard life that only the toughest succeeded—but even the most successful colonials would have gone home to England, if they could have. And that's why the second half of their punishment was an automatic sentence of death if they ever came back. It is at this time in history, in a village close to the marshes along a stretch of the Thames River where the prison-ships anchored, narrator "Pip" cites his earliest memories. He begins his adventures while still a small orphan boy, terrorized by the older sister who has "brought him up by hand," and comforted only by the affection of an earthy, humble brother-in-law, a blacksmith named Joe. One day young Pip falls into the clutches of an escaped convict hiding in the marshes. Trembling under the convict's threats, the boy steals food from his sister and a file from Joe's forge and brings them to the manacled escapee. And though his conscience torments him, and he fears being found out as a thief and accomplice to a fleeing criminal (at least, until the convict is recaptured), Pip does not realize until years later how much this encounter will shape his life.

Lily Bloom, a young, care-free girl, has recently graduated from college and moved to Boston leaving behind her traumatic past to start a new life. Wherein she encounters an enticer, young neurosurgeon, Ryle Kincaid, who is deterministic, arrogant and has his own dark past. Gradually, a sparkle of love ignites between them until their fate says otherwise. Alongside, in her free time, Lily rereads the journal from her past about her parents relationship which inturn affects her own future relationship and her first love Atlas Corrigan, who played a vital role in her

childhood days. Lily's life turns upside down when unexpectedly Atlas resurfaces leaving a taint in her present relationship with Ryle. 'It Ends With Us' is a gut-wrenching, contemporary young-adult fiction and deeply personal story written by Colleen Hoover showcasing a perceptive of being unconditionally loved whilst paying a hefty price.

This story illustrates domestic abuse. From the first line itself, I was imbibed into it. From storyline to plots and its plot twists, I replaced Lily's (author's) narrative with mine. The drifting of emotions while traveling through different timelines is what made me engrossed in it. The way Lily witnessed the violent relationship between her parents is the same unfortunate way she had to experience it with Ryle. I liked the way the author portrays Lily as a strong-willed woman, balancing her current bond while uncovering her past. There were scenes unveiling Ryle's dark side making the story much more unpredictable. Having said that, it made me a little sad hearing about Ryle. Even though he had a dreadful childhood, it's not his fault entirely. In the matter of fact, he has been seeking aids to tackle his problem; yet he's the faulty guy.

The story helped me to weigh value over love for every decision I take as values are stable over time and supported by a sense of character. Loving someone makes you emotionally dependent but always one should have their personal space left untouched. It might seem simple from outside but it is painstaking from inside.

Usually, contemporary fictions talk about a guy meeting a girl and all the joyous moments occur between them. But this book talks particularly about what comes after that and how to

deal with it. In a nutshell, the readers can relate to the emotions of every character. The importance of individualism, conditional love and standing against domestic abuse is well depicted throughout. As the author is well-known for the heart-throbbing ending, it indeed has one which is quite an eye-opener and

inspirational. I would give 5/5 stars. It definitely is a must-read for the YA readers or people who are into mature romantic novels.
