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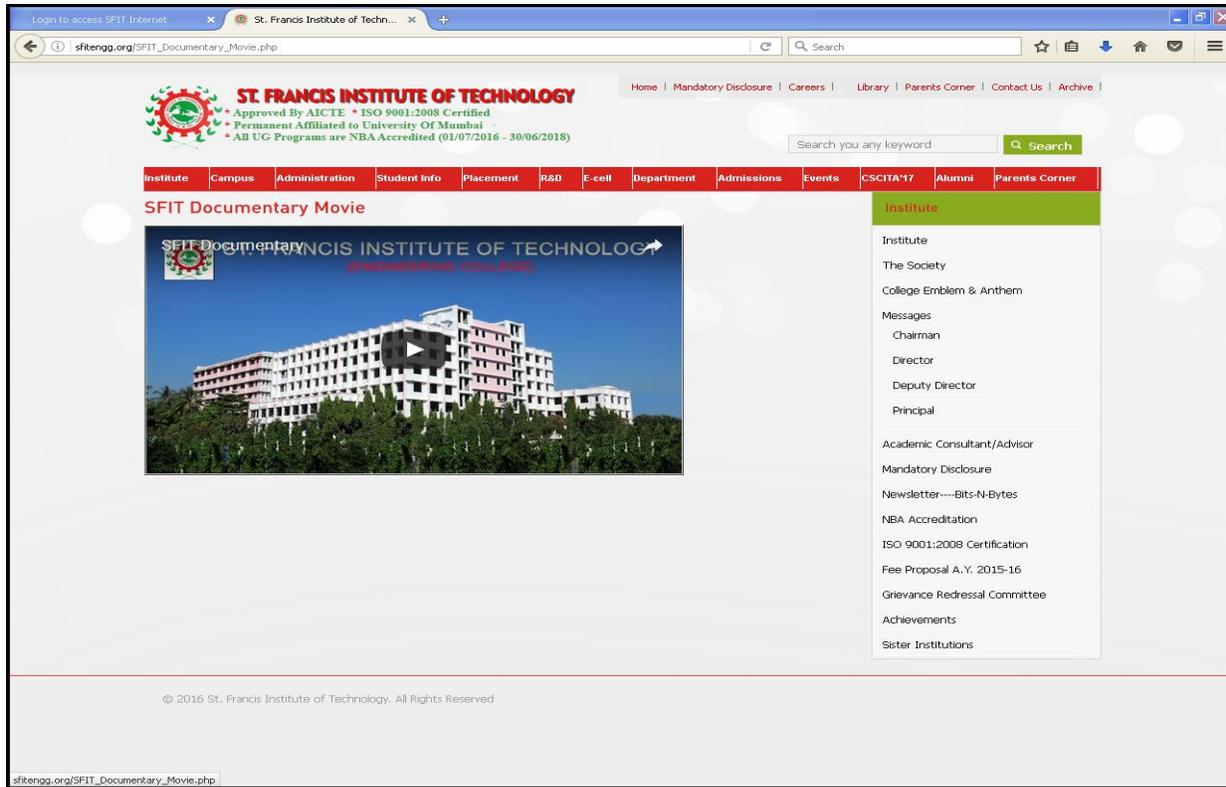

Projects Undertaken

1. Automation of Multi-Rotor Drones:

- A model for autonomous take off and autonomous in-flight control for unmanned aerial vehicles.

2. 2-D Mapping Robot:

- Implemented basic Simultaneous Localization and Mapping (SLAM) algorithm.
- A robot was used to localization and 2D map of the available area was generated.

3. Multi-purpose Intrusion Detection Device (Ninja Box):

- It is an intrusion detection device with an array of applications such as intrusion detection for drawers, cupboards and doors.
- It does not require any setup.

4. Security Wristband:

- Security wristband is a wearable device for kids and women.
